Since 1913, the Florida State Golf Association has been preserving and protecting the game of golf for future generations. We are here to serve Florida's golfers of all ages and abilities.

The FSGA is a volunteer-based organization that includes over 800 member clubs and over 220,000 individual members from across the state. The FSGA provides a variety of services to its member clubs, their members and the general golfing community of Florida. The association conducts more than 500 tournament days each year, including 40 state championships and over 50 days of USGA qualifying events.

A New Century of the FSGA

New for 2014

Each year brings changes, and this year is no different. Below is a summary of items regarding the Women's and One-Day events you can expect in the beginning of our next 100 years of the FSGA!

Women's Championships

- Format and name change was made to the Women's Net Championship (September 6-7 at Orchid Island G&BC)
- Date changes to the following championships: Women's International Four-Ball (moved to Monday-Tuesday, February 17-18), and Women's Net Championship (September 6-7)

One-Day Events (Net Events)

- Over 180 One-Day Events scheduled for 2014!
- More Four-Ball Events and "Stay & Plays" booked
- 65 & Over division approximate yardage changed to 5,700 - 5,800 yards
- Two yardages for women to select from: Women's Forward Tee (5,100 yards) or Women's Middle Tee (5,400 yards)





Women's International Four-Ball Championship

The Wanderers Club

Wellington, FL

Monday, February 17 - Tuesday, February 18, 2014

Entries close Wednesday, January 29, 2014

As the fourth championship in the Orange Blossom Tour that includes the Harder Hall Women's Invitational, the South Atlantic Amateur (SALLY), and the Ione D. Jones/Doherty Championship, the Women's International Four-Ball carries a tremendous amount of history and prestige. The FSGA acquired the championship in early 2012 with the hopes of reviving the historical event. First conducted in 1945 by the Jaycees of Hollywood, Florida, the early championships included the names of Babe Zaharias, Louise Suggs, Peggy Kirk-Bell, and other notables.

Entry Fee

\$360

*Entry fee includes all competitive rounds of golf, Sunday evening cocktail reception with heavy hors d'oeuvre (cash bar), lunch after both Saturday and Sunday rounds, tee gift, and gift certificate prizes.

Championship Format

The format of the championship will be 36 holes of four-ball stroke play, commonly known as a two-person, best-ball. Teams may choose which division they wish to compete in upon entry; the Championship, Middle, or Forward Division. The overall Women's International Four-Ball champion will be the team from the Championship Division with the lowest 36-hole total score.



Divisions & Yardages

Teams may choose to compete in one of the following divisions:

Championship Division - Approx. 6,000 yards (Gross Only)

Middle Division - Approx. 5,500 yards (Gross & Net)

Forward Division - Approx. 5,000 yards (Gross & Net)

Women's Senior Amateur Championship

Golden Ocala Golf & Equestrian Club

Ocala, FL

Monday, April 7 - Tuesday, April 8, 2014

Entries close Wednesday, March 19, 2014

As one of the FSGA's most popular and prestigious events, the Women's Senior Championship is heading to Ocala! Golden Ocala features eight masterfully recreated tribute holes from some of the world's finest courses including Augusta, Royal Troon, Baltusrol, Muirfield, and St. Andrews.

Eligibility

Must be a female amateur member of the FSGA and have reached 50 years of age by April 7, 2014.

Divisions & Approximate Yardages

Players must be 65 years or older as of April 7, 2014 to be eligible to play in the Super-Senior Division, if they so choose. There will be both a Championship and Field Division in each age bracket. Players must select which Division and Field they wish to compete in upon entry.



Senior Championship Division - 5,900 yards approx. (Gross)

Senior Regular Division - 5,400 yards approx. (Gross & Net)

Super-Senior Championship Division - 5,400 yards approx. (Gross)

Super-Senior Regular Division - 4,900 yards approx. (Gross & Net)

Entry Fee

\$175

*Entry fee includes awards luncheon immediately following play on the final round, April 8th.

Championship Format

36 holes of individual stroke play. In the Senior Championship Division and Super-Senior Championship Division it will be gross play only. In the Senior Field Division and Super-Senior Field Division, players may be pre-flighted based on their individual handicaps as of the March 15, 2014 revision. All Field Flights will compete for gross and net prizes.



Women's Mid-Amateur Championship

Entries close Wednesday, April 16, 2014

Eligibility

Must be a female amateur member of the FSGA and have reached 25 years of age by May 3, 2014.

Entry Fee

\$160

*Entry fee includes competition rounds and cart fees, tee gift, and awards luncheon immediately following play after the final round, May 4th.

Handicap Limit

Must have a Florida USGA GHIN Handicap no higher than 34.0.

Championship Format

36 holes of individual stroke play.



The Championship Division will compete for gross prizes only, and the Middle and Forward Divisions will compete for both gross and net prizes.

The Championship Division may be flighted after the first round. Generally, divisions of more than 10 players will be flighted, however the Committee reserves the right to flight based on the number of competitors and/or the range of scores. The Middle and Forward Divisions will likely be pre-flighted based on individual handicaps as of the April 15, 2014 revision. Generally, divisions of more than 10 players will be flighted, however the Committee reserves the right to flight based on the number of competitors and/or the range of combined team handicaps.

Championship Division - Approx. 5,900 yards (Gross Only)

Saturday, June 7 - Wednesday, June 11, 2014

Entries close Wednesday, May 21, 2014



The Women's Amateur Championship is the oldest and most prestigious event on the women's championship schedule. In its 85th year, past champions include the names of Cristie Kerr, Meghan Stasi, Taffy Brower, and other notables.

Eligibility

Must be (1) a resident of Florida (reside in Florida at least 4 months per year, have otherwise established legal residency or graduated from a Florida high school and presently attending an out-of-state college); or (2) a military personnel or a dependent of a military personnel based in Florida on active duty.

Entry Fee

\$150 (\$160 Non-GHIN)

*Entry fee includes player's luncheon following play on Saturday, June 8th and lunches for players during match play days.

Handicap Limit

Must have a USGA GHIN Handicap Index no higher than 18.4.

Championship Format

36 holes of individual stroke play qualifying on Saturday and Sunday. Field will be cut to the top 32 players for the Championship match play field. In the case of a tie for the 32nd seed, there will be a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff.

Round of 32 matches will be played on Monday morning, followed in the afternoon by Round of 16 matches. Quarter-final matches will be played Tuesday morning, with Semi-final matches that afternoon. The final 18 hole Championship match is on Wednesday. **No consolation flights.**

Mixed Team Championship

Entries close on Wednesday, June 11, 2014

Teams have the choice of selecting to compete from two yardage divisions. Mix that with a fun couples trip to gorgeous Vero Beach and you have a great weekend planned already!

Eligibility

At least one entrant of each team must be a member of the FSGA, and both players **MUST** have a valid Florida USGA GHIN Handicap.

Entry Fee

\$300 (per team)

*Entry fee includes cart fees, competitive rounds, tee gift, gift certificate prizes, awards luncheon after play on Sunday.

Handicap Limit

Must have a Florida USGA GHIN Handicap Index no higher than 34.0.

Championship Format

36 holes of four-ball stroke play.

Gross & Net prizes awarded in **BOTH** divisions.

Girls' Junior Amateur Championship

Eligibility

- Open to female amateur golfers ages 13-18 as of June 30, 2014. Entrants must not have reached their 19th birthday by July 2, 2014 and must not be attending college if graduated from high school.
- Players must be (1) a resident of Florida; or (2) a dependent of a military personnel or a military personnel based in Florida on active duty.

Entry Fee

\$120 (ages 13-18)

\$60 (ages 12 & Under)

Championship Format

- **Ages 13 to 18 – Hills Course:** 54 holes of individual stroke play for both the Regular (16-18) and the Junior (13-15) Divisions.
- **12 & Under – Jones Course:** 18 holes of individual stroke play; 9 holes played each day. Round one will be on Monday, June 30th and the final round will be on Tuesday, July 1st.

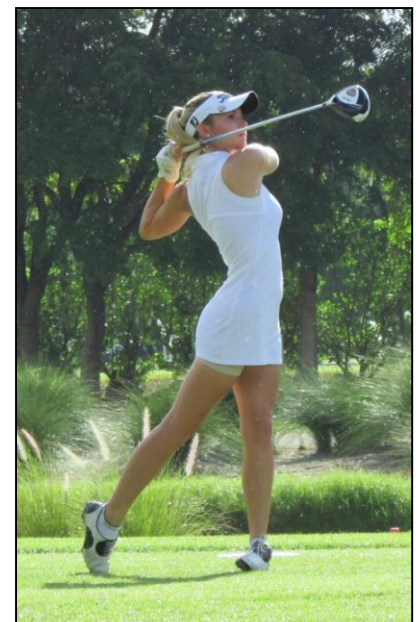

Championship Format

54 Holes of individual Stroke Play. Gross only. Field will be flighted after 36 holes of stroke play.

Championship Division

There will be only one championship division, competing for gross prizes only. The overall 2014 Women's Stroke Play Amateur Champion will be the individual with the lowest 54 hole total score. In the event of a tie for first place in the Championship Flight (or overall champion) there will be a hole-by-hole sudden death playoff on a hole designated by the Committee to determine the champion.

A tradition in Florida for more than 20 years, the FSGA Parent-Child Championship includes men, women, boys and girls of all ages. Parents and Grandparents are eligible to play with their children and grandchildren, and there are multiple age divisions so that everyone can participate!

Eligibility

- At least one entrant of each team must be a member of the FSGA.
- There is no maximum age limit for parent or child (13 & older – 18 holes)
- Professionals can play and are only eligible for trophies or prizes in the junior division (12 and under - 9-holes).
- Grandparents may also play with grandchildren.

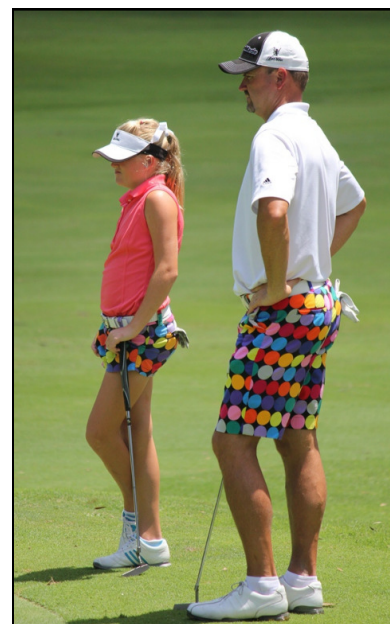
Ages

- Child must be age 13 or older as of July 26, 2014 to compete in the regular division (18 holes) broken into age divisions (Ages 18 & under, 19-28, and 29 & older child must be age 6 or older as of July 26, 2014 to play in the junior division (9 holes) broken into ages (Ages 6-7, 8-9, and 10-12)
- A child 6-12 years of age can move up to the Regular Division, but a child age 13 or older may not move down.

Entry Fee

18 Holes - \$280 (\$300 without GHIN discount)

9 Holes - \$140 (\$160 without GHIN discount)



Championship Format

9 Hole Format: The format of play for the Junior Division is Modified Alternate Shot using Stableford scoring each day. Both players hit tee shots from their respective tees. Both players then hit the second shot with the other's ball. After the second shot, the team chooses which ball it will use to complete play of the hole hitting the chosen ball alternately for the remainder of the hole.

18 Hole Format: The format of play is 36 holes of Modified Alternate Shot stroke play. The lowest total for 36 holes within each division is Champion.

Invitation Only

Georgia will be host to the 2014 Women's Southeastern Challenge Matches between Florida, Georgia, and Alabama. The matches will be conducted at Reynolds Plantation on the Great Waters course in Greensboro, GA.

Eligibility

Invitation only.

Championship Format

- First day: Two matches consisting of morning four-ball matches and afternoon foursome (alternate shot) matches.
- Second day: 12 total single matches, with a player from each association in each match competing against one another (three-ball match).



Teams

The FSGA selects a twelve (12) player team to represent Florida in this competition against Georgia and Alabama consisting of four (4) Women Senior Amateurs (50 and older) and eight (8) other women of which no more than two (2) junior players of age 17 and under. The team selections includes:

- (2) Women Senior players with highest point totals from the Women's Senior Two Year Points List
- (2) Women Senior player selected by the FSGA Championship Committee
- (3) Women players with the highest point totals from the Women Two Year Points List
- (5) Women players selected by the FSGA Championship Committee

Players will be chosen and invited by the Championship Committee with selection criteria to include, but not be limited to, the FSGA Player of the Year points list standings as of July 14, 2014 after the FSGA Women's Amateur Stroke Play Championship.

Must be a female amateur member of the FSGA with a valid Florida USGA GHIN handicap.

*Entry fee includes both competitive rounds, cart fees, tee gifts, and awards luncheon following play on Sunday, October 16th.



Handicap Limit

Must have a Florida USGA GHIN Handicap Index of no higher than 34.0 as of the August 15, 2014 revision.

Championship Format

36 Holes of Net Individual Stroke Play. Players will be pre-flighted based on their current handicap index as of August 15, 2014. Generally, divisions of more than 10 people will be flighted, however the Committee reserves the right to flight based on the number of competitors and/or the range of handicaps.



Course Set-up

Players may select which division they wish to compete in upon entry.

Middle Division - 5,500 yards approximately (Net)

Forward Division - 5,000 yards approximately (Net)

2013 PLAYERS-OF-THE-YEAR



Amateur Player of the Year: Meghan Stasi

Oakland Park native, Meghan Stasi, is no stranger to the 2013 Women's Player of the Year honors, earning it for the fourth year in a row. Stasi clinched an impressive 20,333 points for the year. Starting the year off on fire, she captured the Women's International Four-Ball title with partner Tara Connelly. In July, Stasi finished third at the Florida Women's Amateur Stroke Play Championship at The Forest Country Club. Stasi continued her success at the USGA level, making it to the round of 32 at the United States Women's Amateur and finishing as a semifinalist at the United States Women's Mid-Amateur. Stasi also represented team Florida at The USGA State Team Championship where the team finished second behind New Jersey. This past month she also helped the South team claim the cup at the Inaugural Women's Florida Cup. However, the highlight of Stasi's season came in September when she captured the Inaugural Florida Women's.

Senior Player of the Year: Mary Jane Hiestand

Mary Jane Hiestand, of Naples, is the 2013 Senior Women's Player of the Year for the fourth year in a row earning 17,380 overall points. Hiestand had a fantastic year, which she started off by claiming the championship title at the Women's Senior Amateur at Worthington Country Club. With a victory under her belt, she continued on by finishing as a quarterfinalist in the Ione Jones/Doherty Senior Championship and making it to the round of 32 at the 84th Florida Women's Amateur Championship. With partner Diane Lang, Hiestand claimed second place at the Florida Women's Four-Ball Championship and third place at the Women's International Four-Ball Championship. Mary Jane has also been successful in USGA championships, qualifying for the United States Women's Mid-Amateur Championship and making it all the way to the semifinals in the U.S. Women's Senior Amateur Championship. Hiestand also helped the South team claim victory at the Inaugural Women's Florida Cup.



Junior Player of the Year: Yueer "Cindy" Feng

Earning a record-breaking 30,730 overall points in her final season as an amateur golfer, Yueer "Cindy" Feng, of Orlando, has captured the 2013 Girls Junior Player of the Year honors. Feng earned the majority of her points by qualifying and finishing runner-up at the United States Women's Amateur Championship. Similarly, Feng qualified and made the cut at the United States Women's Open and was also a quarterfinalist at the United States Girls' Junior Championship. Continuing her success, Feng finished as the runner-up at The North & South Championship at Pinehurst. Feng also holds the record for the most Florida Junior Tour wins with an impressive 30 first place finishes.
