



Earsley Captures Senior Amateur Championship

Steve Earsley held onto his second round lead during the final round of the **Senior Amateur Championship** at **Black Diamond Ranch** in Lecanto to capture the victory. In the Super Senior Division, **Brian Sachs** had a come-from-behind victory.

Steve Earsley, of Hobe Sound, captured his first **Florida State Golf Association Championship** by stringing together rounds of 72-72-75 for a 219 tournament total and a three stroke victory. Earsley, the 2003 and 2004 **Golfweek** #1 ranked player-of-the year and 2007 FSGA Senior Amateur runner-up, started with a birdie at the first hole in his final round. Adding another birdie to get to two under, he gave away strokes at holes seven and eight after shortsiding himself on his approach and leaving difficult up-and-downs that resulted in bogies. The bad luck continued on the back nine, with a string of four bogies in the first four holes. He again shortsided himself on the tenth hole, three-putted both the eleventh and twelfth holes, and missed a three-footer on the thirteenth. Battling with a trio of contenders, Earsley found himself with only a one stroke lead with five holes to play. Bolstered by a par on the fourteenth hole, Steve stuck his approach shot to a foot on the fifteenth to give him a tap-in birdie. “The panic had started to set-in. After I parred fourteen and hit it to one-foot on fifteen I felt a whole lot better,” Earsley remarked. A birdie on the eighteenth hole sealed the victory. **Jim Carley**, of Ormond Beach, shot the only under-par round of the day in the Senior Division to leap into a tie for second place after shooting rounds of 78-73-71 for a 222 tournament total. **John Darr**, of Gainesville, also finished second with rounds of 75-74-73.

Brian Sachs, of Newberry, overcame a six-stroke deficit to have an impressive come-from-behind victory in the Super Senior Division. Tied for fourth place heading into the final round, Sachs scorched the course, returning the only under-par round in the Super Senior Division. He followed his rounds of 78 and 76 with a one-under par 71 to win by three strokes. **Edward Craig**, of Orlando, finished in second place with rounds of 76-78-74 for a 228 total. **Ed Duffy**, of West Palm Beach, shot rounds of 72-76-81 for a 229 total and claimed third place honors. **Full results page 6.**

Graham and Kroeger win Senior/Mid-Am at Lake Wales

2009 Senior/Mid-Am Four-Ball Champions

The team of **AJ Kroeger** and **Joseph Graham** went wire-to-wire winning the **6th Senior/Mid-Amateur Four-Ball Championship** at **Lake Wales Country Club** in Lake Wales on April 4-5.

After the first round, the pair led the field by one stroke shooting a seven-under par 63. Graham, of Deer Island, and Kroeger, from Apopka, held off the late charging, white-hot duo of **Robert Levy** and **Tim Hume** in the second round, posting another 63 to win the Championship with a 126 tournament total. This victory gives Graham and Kroeger an exemption into the **2009 Four-Ball Championship**, to be played at the **Ritz-Carlton's Members Golf Club** in Bradenton. Levy, from Windermere, and Hume, of Tampa, sat two strokes out of the lead going into the final round. Posting a 62, the lowest round of the tournament, they came up one stroke short, settling for second place. [Full Results on page 6](#).

Hume Wins Inaugural Mid-Am Stroke Play

The inaugural **Mid-Amateur Stroke Play Championship** at **Sara Bay Country Club** needed extra holes to determine a winner. **Tim Hume** and **Mark Leetzow** tied after 54 holes and squared off on the eighteenth hole for a sudden death playoff with Tim Hume emerging as the victor.

Tim Hume, of Tampa, recorded the only under par round of the entire event in the final round, a one-under par 71 to follow his prior rounds of 73 and 75 for a tournament total of 219, to tie for first place with Mark Leetzow, of Sarasota. Leetzow was tied for second place headed into the last eighteen holes. Shooting a one-over par 73, combined with a 72 and 74 in rounds one and two, he played his way into a playoff for the Championship. The sudden-death playoff took place on the par-5 eighteenth hole. Tim Hume managed par while Mark Leetzow bogeyed and Hume claimed the title. The second round leader, **Frank Babusik**, of Pompano Beach, finished two strokes back at 221 and earned third place honors.

The first-ever Florida State Golf Association's Mid-Amateur Championship was held at the historic Sara Bay Country Club. Sara Bay has hosted numerous FSGA Championships, including the 1995 State Amateur, 1999 Senior Amateur, 2003 Senior Four-Ball, and the 2007 Senior Match Play. Designed by Donald Ross, Sara Bay is regarded as one of Florida's best classic courses. It was the site of the famous match between **Bobby Jones** and **Walter Hagen**, and has claimed **Tommy Armour** and **Joe Turnesa** as head golf professionals. Hume earbed exemptions into this year's Amateur, Amateur-Match Play and Mid-Amateur Championships with his victory.

The Mid-Amateur Stroke play is for players who are at least 25 years of age and older. The Mid-Amateur Stroke Play Championship is conducted over fifty-four holes of individual stroke play. All players play thirty-six holes, with a cut instituted after thirty-six holes. The players who make the cut play the final round the following day. [Full results on page 7](#).

Damron, Schwenke & Mulvoy win Winter Series Finale

Mike Damron went wire-to-wire to secure the **Florida State Golf Association's Winter Series Finale**, at **Lake Jovita Golf & Country Club** in Dade City, March 29-31. He was joined in the winners circle by **Kim Schwenke** and **Mark Mulvoy**, who won the Senior and Super Senior divisions respectively.

In the Mid-Senior Division, Mike Damron of Zephyrhills, who won the 2008 Brooksville Winter Series title, jumped to an early lead with a two-under par 70 in round one. He built on his two-stroke lead in round two, shooting a 73 and staying atop the leaderboard by three strokes. Playing steady golf, Mike lapped the field in the final round, closing with a three-under par 69 and a seven-stroke victory. **KC Fox**, of Sarasota, finished second with rounds of 75-73-71.

In the Senior Division, Kim Schwenke fired a seven-under par 65 to come from eight-strokes back to claim the victory. Schwenke, who has three previous Winter Series titles, shot 78-73 in his first two rounds to sit well back of the leader, **Brian Hawke**. Shooting a 32 on the front nine, with four birdies, Schwenke poured in three more birdies for a 33 on the back nine and a one-stroke victory. Hawke, of Temple Terrace, finished second with rounds of 68-75-74.

The Super-Senior Division saw Mark Mulvoy come from four-strokes behind to secure the win. Mulvoy, shot 75-81 in his first two rounds. Coming out strong in the final round, he shot a one-under par 71 to win by a stroke over **Bill Dorece**. Dorece, of Pompano Beach, shot rounds of 77-75-76. **Full results on page 7.**

Winter Series Points Wrap Up

In addition to a winner's trophy, the Winter Series points race and an exemption into the State Amateur was up for grabs during the Winter Series Final at **Lake Jovita Golf & Country Club**. The current year's final Winter Series Mid-Senior points leader receives an exemption into the **FSGA State Amateur Championship**, to be conducted at **TPC Sawgrass & Sawgrass Country Club** June 25-28.

Going into the final event, **John Wegmann**, of Southwest Ranches, held a slim five-point lead over **Samuel Martinez**, of Miami. They both tied for fourth place in the Winter Series Finale, allowing Wegmann to maintain his five-point lead, finishing the season with 690 points, and thus earning the exemption into the 2009 Amateur Championship.



Senior Championship Ruling

The Senior Championship kicked off the 2009 Major Championship Season with a bang for rulings. In the final round, a player hit his ball into a greenside bunker on the par-3 thirteenth hole. His ball came to rest in a poor lie near the lip of the bunker. His next stroke failed to extricate the ball and it rolled down into his footprints. He deemed his Ball Unplayable under Rule 28 and proceeded under the second option (b) of that Rule. Instead of staying in the bunker, he incorrectly dropped a ball outside the bunker on a line keeping the point at which the ball lay between the hole and him resulting in his Playing from a Wrong Place under Rule 20-7c. Regretably, the player completed the hole and played off the next teeing ground without correcting his error. The incident was brought to the attention of the Committee.

The Committee ruled that the player had committed a serious breach of the Rule and that he incurred a penalty of disqualification.

As an official, a good day is a day without rulings. Let's hope that our next major of the year, the Amateur Championship, is not quite as eventful as the first!

2009 Interclub Championship won by Hunter's Green CC at Juliette Falls

Hunter's Green Country Club had a come-from-behind victory in the **2009 Men's Interclub Team Championship at Juliette Falls** in Dunnellon, April 4-5. After six weeks of matches and two rounds of play-offs, Hunter's Green beat out six other Regional Champions to be crowned the Interclub State Champions.

Hunter's Green earned 199 stableford points in the first round to sit four points behind the first round leader and 2008 Champions, **LaCita Golf & Country Club**. Coming out strong in the second round, Hunter's Green rallied from behind and posted 214 points to lap the field by five points, earning a tournament total of 413 points. LaCita Golf & Country Club finished in second with 409 points, while **Amelia Island Plantation** finished in third place with 408 points.

After two rounds of playoffs, Hunter's Green Country Club, in Tampa, won the Tampa Bay Region. LaCita Golf and Country Club, in Titusville, emerged as the Central Region Champions. Amelia Island Plantation, in Amelia Island, grabbed the title of the Northeast Region. **Rainbow Springs Golf & Country Club**, from Dunnellon, won the Ocala Region. **Miccosukee Country Club**, from Miami, claimed the South Region title, **Indian Bayou Golf Club**, in Destin, claimed the Panhandle Region, and **Tampa Bay Golf and Country Club**, in San Antonio, captured the North Tampa Bay Region title.
