LEHIGH ACRES, (CCI)---Mike Yahl of Naples shot a steady even par 71 to win the 1980 FSGA Life Begins at Forty Tournament this past weekend. The Champ's two day total 210, three under par over the Lehigh Acres Country Club layout, was good for a three shot victory over Bill Earley and Larry Cunningham.

Cunningham held a one shot lead at the end of 36 holes on rounds of 69 both days, but Yahl quickly moved out in front on the opening nine and coasted to victory. Bill Earley the defending champ closed with a final round 72 to tie Cunningham for second. Cunningham closed with a 75.

The low round of the tournament was 68 by Yahl and Rom Clayton of Sarasota. Clayton finished fourth six shots off the pace.

In the 50-59 age group Holland Aplin Tampa came from six shots off the pace to tie Hank Phillips also of Tampa for the title. Phillips led going into the final round after shooting 70 and 72, but he stumbled to a 78 the final day as Aplin pulled up even with a closing 72.

In the 60-69 age group Lynn Lee, Sebring and George Baumgarner finished in a tie at 222 after a final round dogfight which saw Lee come from one shot back. Lee fired a final round 75 and Bumgarner finished with 76.

It was all Dexter Daniels in the 70 and over age group. The Winter Haven Legend opened a six shot lead on rounds of 78 and 80 and then e

coasted home to a seven shot victory. Daniels closed with a final round 83 and 247 a 241 total. Don Schwartz of Naples was second with 84 for 248.

144 golfers teed it up at the popular event which also features a team competition the first two days.
