Ron Clayton, Sarasota, won the overall championship of the 1982 Bill Carey Life Begins at Forty Championship.

Ron opened with a round of 73 on the Mirror Lakes Country Club Course and returned Saturday with a 70 on Lehigh Country Club. Ron shot a final round of 74 to tie Holland Aplin of Tampa for the gross score. Holland had a steady tournament with rounds of 73, 73, and 71. On the first extra hole of the sudden death play-off, both players had ten to fifteen ^{foot} putts for birdies, but both managed par after Aplin's putt spun out the low side. Both returned routine pars on the second hole. The third hole Aplin's drive hit a hard spot and went through the fairway into the trees. He managed a great trouble shot which missed the green to the right. Aplin chipped to within eight feet but was unable to match Clayton's par.

Ron LeClair, Oviedo who is perennially close won the 40-49 Age Division one stroke back of the leaders with a 218 total based on rounds of 75, 71, 72. Last year's champion, Charley McCormick was tied for third in the 50-59 Division with a 225 score based on rounds 73, 76, 76. M.T. McInnis won the 60-69 Division with 77, 73, 74, 224 total. Carl Gustafson won the 70 and Over Division with totals 74, 78, 78, 230.

This was a full field of 160 contestants and the Championship was played on both Lehigh Country Club and Mirror Lakes Country Club all three days.
