### Tampa golfers win Club Team Championship

STUART — Rick Brown and Doug LaCrosse led Palma Ceia of Tampa to victory in the 44th annual Club Team Championship of the Florida State Golf Association at Martin Downs.

Brown birdied the 17th hole and

parred the 18th to pull Palma Ceia into a tie with two teams from Bear Lakes Country Club in West Palm Beach, all at 593. In the playoff, LaCrosse made a par-saving 18-foot putt on the first extra hole and won it with a 30-footer for a birdie on the second hole.

Tom Knapp of Bear Lakes-A was the low scorer for the tournament with 73-69—142, followed by John Sanford of Bear Lakes-B at 76-67—143 and Mike Malizia of Martin Downs. 69-74—143. LaCrosse led

Palma Ceia with 74-71—145. Brown shot 74-74—148.

Host Martin Downs was fourth at 594.

### Martin Downs hosting team championship

PALM CITY — Martin Downs will be the site of the Florida State Golf Association Club Team Championship today and Sunday. Twenty-four teams, including three from Martin Downs, will be competing in the tournament.

The event features six-player teams representing 13 clubs from around the state. Each competitor will play one round on the Martin Downs Crane Creek and Tower courses. Tee-off time is 8 a.m. both days.

### Palma Ceia Golf Club wins State Team title

PALM CITY — Doug LaCrosse sank a 30-foot birdie putt on the second playoff hole Sunday to give the Palma Ceia Golf Club a victory in the Florida State Club Team Championships played at Martin Downs Country Club west of Stuart.

Trailing both the A and B teams from West Palm Beach's Bear Lake Country Club by five strokes when the second and final day of the tournament began, Palma Ceia forced a three-way tie with the first-round leaders at the end of regulation. Scoring was done by combining the four lowest rounds of each club's six-man team. In the playoff, each team selected two players to play sudden death.

Joining LaCrosse, the Palma Ceia club champ, for the playoff was Rick Brown. Other Palma Ceia team members were Jack Boyett, Jeff Henderson, Rob Irvin and Dick Goerlich.

The two Bear Lake teams and Palma Ceia finished the two days of regulation play with 593 totals. All three teams had par on the first playoff hole and then Palma Ceia won with a par by Brown and LaCrosse's bird.

This was Palma Ceia's first State Club Team title, but not the first for Tampa. For the five previous years, the championship had been won by either Avila or Bloomingdale.

In other golf news:

■ At Syracuse, N.Y., Dave Hill, 51, won his second tournament of 1988 in easy fashion, claiming \$37,500 of the \$250,000 Syracuse Senior Classic by five strokes over Bobby Nichols and Butch Baird. Hill shot a 4-under 68 for a 16-under 200.

■ At Malmo, Sweden, Frank Nobilo of New Zealand scored a one-stroke victory over England's Howard Clark to win the \$350,000 PLM Open.

■ At Tokyo, Masashi "Jumbo" Ozaki outdueled younger brother Naomichi Ozaki over the front nine and breezed to a four-stroke victory in the Nikkei Cup. Also in Toyko, American Tammie Green closed with a 1-over par 73 to win the rain-shortened \$265,000 Tokyo Open and gain her first pro victory.
