

HOLLIS CLAIMS THE FLORIDA STATE JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

BUENA VISTA, Fla. — Andy Hollis of Palm Beach Gardens shot a career- low 31 on the front nine of the 43rd Florida State Junior Golf Championship to distance himself from his competitors. The 16-year old ended with a 2-under 70 to claim the championship by two strokes over West Palm Beach's Matthew LeConche at Walt Disney World's Magnolia and Palm courses in Lake Buena Vista.

Hollis led after the first round by one stroke. His six birdies and three bogeys gave him a first round 69. After making par on the first three holes in his final round, Hollis closed his front nine with five birdies and a par. He birdied the tenth hole to go to 9-under for the tournament. The birdie-barrage ended at the 371-yard, par 4 eleventh when Hollis fired two balls into the water and ended with a triple bogey. From there, he just played consistent golf to bring the final round to a close.

"I really played solid the last couple of days," Hollis said after claiming the championship trophy. "I slowed down on the back nine today. I have been putting well, but today I putted a lot better. The triple bogey on 11 was my only bad hole."

LeConche finished two strokes back with a 72-69--141. His final-round 69 was the low score for day two.

Matt Every of Daytona Beach was the champion of the 12-14 age group. His 75- 73--148 placed him tied for tenth overall and one shot ahead of Orlando's Andy Leadbetter for the 12-14 title. Every, a 14-year old who will attend Mainland High School, made three birdies and four bogeys on his way to a final-round 73.

"I hit the ball well today," Every said. "I hit the driver well and kept it in the fairway. All my birdies followed a bogey, so my recovery was pretty good."

"I expected par to win it. I just tried to come in and keep it around even. I birdied 17 from a fairway bunker and went ahead by a stroke. I had a tap-in one putt on 18 for par, and when Andy (Leadbetter) made par, I knew I had won."

LAKE BUENA VISTA, Florida - Andy Hollis of Palm Beach Gardens fired a 3-under 69 t lead after the first round of the Florida State Junior Championship. Brian Dilley of Titusville, Justin Watzka of Orlando and Robby Slye of Mary Esther are just a stroke behind with a 2-under 70. Defending champion Brad Stainsby of Lakeland shot a 76.

The Florida State Junior Championship is a 36-hole event. Golfers compete on two Disney courses; 18 holes on the Palm and 18 holes on the Magnolia.

Hollis, who played his first round at Disney's Palm course, had a round that included 6 birdies, 9 pars and 3 bogeys. Dilley shot the lowest score at the Magnolia with a 70, Orlando's Will Lloyd shot a 71 at the Magnolia, but no other golfer broke 76.

The final round starts tomorrow at 7:30 a.m. The leaders will begin play at 9:36 a.m. on the Magnolia course.
